School Block Challenge 2020 *Fabric Packet Request Form*

Students in grades K-12 throughout the United States are invited to enter this annual contest. Moda Fabrics provides the 3 challenge fabrics in each packet. Materials are limited; therefore entry packets will be distributed as requests are received. Prize money will be awarded to the teacher/parent of the winning students for arts education/quiltmaking. All blocks will be exhibited at the National Quilt Museum in early 2020.

Notes:

- ❖ Teachers/Parents may receive a maximum of 10 packets; 1 packet can be used for multiple blocks.
- ❖ Each block must include a recognizable piece of each challenge fabric & some type of hand or machine stitching.
- ❖ Teachers/Parents may submit multiple entries; however students can only be represented on one (1) block.
- ❖ Students can make a block on their own, at school in the classroom, in a home school program, with a Scout Troop, in a 4-H club, as part of some other club/organization, etc.
- ❖ Students may ask for help from a quilter or other adult when using sewing machines & tools.
