



Meet Award-winning North Carolina Modern Quilter, Charles Cameron, at The National Quilt Museum, November 18-November 20, 2025

Paducah, KY, November 10, 2025 – The National Quilt Museum is excited to announce that acclaimed quilter Charles Cameron will be in attendance from November 18–20, 2025, offering several meet-and-greet sessions and an artist talk in conjunction with his current exhibition, *A Curious Modern Quilter*.

Charles, a North Carolina-based modern quilter, is an engineer by training and vocation, while tending toward creative endeavors to maintain balance. His daughters' playful experimentation and inquisitive approach to learning are models for his curiosity. His quilts have been published in *Curated Quilts*, a quarterly journal for and by modern quilters, and juried into QuiltCon, the world's largest modern quilt show.

His quilt "Sudoku", displayed in the current exhibition, was awarded first place in the Small Quilts Category at QuiltCon 2022. Charles loves to share his work. He has written and published quilt patterns of his own design, delivered lectures to guilds, hosted trunk shows, and conducted workshops across the country.

He will be at The National Quilt Museum for meet-and-greets on Tuesday, November 18, from 2:00 to 4:00 p.m., and on Thursday, November 20, from 2:00 to 3:30 p.m. On Wednesday, November 19, Charles will give an artist talk about his exhibition, *A Curious Modern Quilter*, from 10:00 a.m. to 12:00 noon.

Charles will return to The National Quilt Museum to teach a three-day workshop, *Crooked Crosses & Bent Boxes*, from March 12-14, 2026. Registration is now underway, and interested participants may reserve their space at [Quiltmuseum.org/classes](https://quiltmuseum.org/classes).

The National Quilt Museum is located at 215 Jefferson Street in Paducah, Kentucky, and is open daily from 10 a.m. to 5 p.m. Monday through Saturday and 1 p.m. to 5 p.m. on Sunday. Tickets may be purchased online or upon arrival. Complimentary parking is available onsite. Admission is \$15 for adults, \$13 for seniors (62 and older) and military, \$5 for students, and complimentary for children under 12 with a paying adult and members.
